Exactly 20 years ago, German police officers cowardly killed our Brother Oury JALLOH (20 y. o. and Father of one) in the most horrible way in the city of Dessau. As a reminder, they illegally arrested and arbitrarily detained him simply because he was Black. Once in the police cell, they savagely beat and cruelly tortured him. And when they realized that he wouldn't survive their beatings, abuse and torture, they burned him alive to erase the traces of their barbaric crime.

As we have done every year since 2005, we will gather in Dessau on Tuesday, January 7, 2025 to demand Truth, Justice and Reparations for our martyred Brother Oury Jalloh and his Family. Please come and bring your acquaintances, friends and family!

Unfortunately, the murder of Oury Jalloh is not an isolated crime. In fact, the German police, judiciary and other institutions are notorious for taking a morbid pleasure in discriminating against, oppressing and murdering Black children, youth, men and women for racist reasons.

The demonstration for Oury Jalloh is therefore also the same struggle for truth and justice for all other Black victims of racist oppression and murder in Germany.

Together, let us show the racist German police who cowardly executed our Children, Sisters and Brothers, the racist German justice system that protects the murderous police and guarantees them impunity, and the German state that maintains and employs this racist mafia that we remain united and determined to fight until the police who tortured and murdered Oury Jalloh and our other Martyrs are convicted and punished and the German state pays Reparations to their Families.
